IV INFUSION CODING: CPT CHEAT SHEET

 HYDRATION (96360, 96361)	 THERAPUTIC INFUSION (96365, 96364 etc..)
Intent: Fluids/Electrolytes ONLY <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Sodium Chloride, Saline• D5W• Bolus/IV Flush	Intent: Drug Delivery <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Zofran• Toradol• Dilaudid
Timing <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Must be 31 minutes+• Must have a recorded stop time• Cannot be at the same time as any therapeutic infusion	Timing <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Must be 16 minutes+• <16 minutes = IVP• Multiple IVP given at the same exact time can only be billed once
Key: NO DRUGS ADDED <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Minimum duration: 31 minutes2. Rate: must be at least >125 mL/h3. No concurrent infusions4. Required documentation	Key: DRUGS ADDED TO BAG <ul style="list-style-type: none">• If the drug is for CRNA, radiology anesthesia, self administrable those type of drugs are not billable on the facility level

IV > IVP > IM > HYDRATION in hierarchy
